Lead poisoning is a serious condition that can cause irreversible damage to babies and young children. Genesee County Health Department will host a lead screening clinic on Monday, February 29 at Genesee County Community Action Resource Department's (GCCARD) Headstart. The clinic will focus on babies and kids under the age of 6.
